Minute item	Update
3. Bude Business Voice project	Project going forward as planned. Three focus group meetings have been scheduled (Feb 2021). As previously advised, there is a separate website for BBV - <a href="https://www.budebusinessvoice.co.uk/">https://www.budebusinessvoice.co.uk/</a>
4. Bude Area Community Network Panel meeting – 7 December	The Action Notes from ZBJ were circulated on 24 December 2020.
5. BCCT future funding	My email of 15 December included a copy of a discussion document about possible funding options, and provided details of the informal meeting with BSTC on Friday 11 December. PT subsequently emailed BSTC saying “we await guidance/information from the Council as to the way forward.” Further ideas and options are under consideration.
6 a) Bude Climate Partnership	The new account with Cooperative Bank has been opened and the initial instalment from National Lottery has been received. A Financial Procedures Manual setting out responsibilities of BCP and BCCT is being finalised by AB jointly with peter Smith, BCP Treasurer.
6 b) Town Team – (Meeting 10 December)	No information available
6 c) Social Action Fund (a joint project with Neetside Community Centre)	As at 7 Jan 2021, £942 has been raised from 17 donors
6 d) CIL Fund applications	Outcome awaited.
6 e) Creative Economy project	The small working group aims to set up a special Facebook page to facilitate engagement with businesses in the creative sector. As the CC Creative Manifesto is a 5-year plan, BCCT has asked that this project be added to the Bude Stratton Strategic Programme (BSSP).
6 f) Pearl Bamford Community Garden (a joint project with Bude Cleaner Seas)	Crowdfunder project successfully completed. Target was £5000; £6125 raised.
