MINUTES

1. Apologies for absence.

2. To agree the minutes of the meeting on 7 December 2020

Agreed.

3. BSSP - Bude-Stratton Strategic Programme (the schedule to the MoU collaboration agreement involving CC, BSTC, CIOs LEP and BCCT)

As usual, once the table of projects in the BSSP has been circulated and agreed by participants at the BSSP meeting a copy will be circulated.

4. Bude Area Community Network Panel

Information on the agenda was noted.

Next step is to await the notes from the CNP meeting on 1 March.

5. Localism

A brief discussion led to a steering group recommendation that BCCT supports the principles underlying the Localism Strategy and will continue to collaborate with relevant parties.

It was recognised that implementing the Localism Strategy would be under the control of Cornwall Council and Bude-Stratton Town Council.

6. Updates on current BCCT projects – and related developments/initiatives

a) Bude Business Voice (BBV)

TB provided an update about the project and details of the next two Focus Group meetings.

b) Climate Action Fund – Bude Climate Partnership (BCP)

Information on the agenda was noted.

c) Bude Creative Economy project

The information on the agenda was noted – and it was recognised that lack of resources and the Covid pandemic was limiting the rate of progress.

d) Town Team.

PLB reported that further meetings of the Town Team are to take place to establish the priorities to form the basis of an application to Cornwall Council's Town Vitality Fund.

As the priority of the Town Team is focussed on attracting funds for economic development, it was agreed that TB should replace IS as BCCT's representative on the Town Team.

e) Bude-Stratton Social Action Fund. (SAF)

Current position noted.

f) CIL Fund applications.

For information. As advised (email 20 January) the two applications in which BCCT was involved were successful. These were:

- A community car scheme, submitted by Co-Cars Ltd showing BCCT as the lead partner, for £58,000 to set up support for 2 electric cars (and associated charging points). BSTC have agreed that they will be located at the Parkhouse Centre.
- A grant of £45,702 for Budehaven Community School for accommodation together with a wildlife garden for pupils at risk of exclusion. This application was drafted by IS on behalf of the School.

g) Pearl Bamford Community Garden at Budehaven School

For information. As a formally registered CIC, BCCT agreed to collaborate with Bude Cleaner Seas in a Crowdfunder for this amenity with a target of £5000. The total realised was £6125.

h) Any other BCCT projects/initiatives

No matters were raised.

7. BCCT's future

Much discussion, centred around the need for a collaborative community organisation, though with limited/sparse out resources (manpower and funds) progress was slow.

It was agreed to continue discussions with BSTC and other potential partners, and explore opportunities via projects within BSSP, Bude Business Voice project and other initiatives.

8. Any other business

No other business.

9. Date of next meeting
